







- Posi-Tap instructions must be followed exactly as described in this instruction




# Vehicle outline with installation overview



- 1) Apply parking brake
- 2) Turn ignition switch to "ON" position
- 3) Record the customer radio presets and other presets as required


- 4) Put the shift lever in "P" position for A/T or "1st" for M/T
- 5) Turn the ignition switch to "OFF" position




6) Disconnect the negative battery terminal

# **A** CAUTION


- Take care not to scratch or damage any component during the removal or re-installation process.
- Trim pieces found to have witness marks or broken clips are not to be reinstalled.
- 7) Remove the following vehicle parts in the sequence shown below. Store these re-usable parts in a safe and protected manner.



- 1 Instrument side finisher RH
- 2 Glove Box




- 8) Remove instrument side finisher RH
  - a) Insert panel trim removal tool into lowe spaceinstument side finisher RH (1) fixing pawls
  - b) Pull back on instrument side finisher




- 9) Remove glove box assembly
  - a) Open the glove box lid
  - b) Remove (7) phillips screws
  - c) Pull glove box assembly
  - d) Disconnect glove box lamp harness connector

### 10) Remove the BCM

a) Remove (4) Phillips screws from the BCM mounting bracket.








b) Position BCM to expose wiring

# **▲** CAUTION

- Color(s) given in illustration(s) are for reference only. Use location(s) where color deviates.
- If a vehicle wire is being used by another accessory and a posi-Tap is present, tap the accessory wire not the vehicle wire
- 11) Tap the Vehicle Tracking and Recovery System Red wire to the vehicle Dark Green B+ wire.







- 12) Tap vehicle wire.
  - a) Remove cap (slot side) from the tap body
  - b) Slide cap around vehicle wire.
  - c) Tighten the tap **TIGHT** with finger pressure.


#### NOTE:

Do not re-use the tap for subsequent reinstallation. Figures are not to scale.

13) Inspect the tap to ensure correct installation.

### NOTE:

Avoid putting pressure on the vehicle wire and tap for the remainder of the installation.




- i. Straight and evenly spaced all around ii. Tight and no gap and test the signal




- 14) Tap accessory wire.
  - a) Remove tap (non-pierce) side from tap.
  - b) Remove the protective stub from the wire.
  - c) Insert wire through the non-pierce side opening.
  - d) Spread the individual strands into fan shape.
  - e) Insert wire into the tap body and ensure that it is all the way in.
  - f) Tighten the tap **TIGHT** with finger pressure.
- 15) Confirm the tapped accessory wire.
  - a) Inspect the tap to ensure correct installation.
  - b) Test the signal to ensure that it is working properly.
- 16) Secure the tap.
  - Secure the tapped wire on the non-pierce side to the body of the tap with electrical tape (≥ 2 revolutions).
  - b) Secure the body to harness where vehicle wire is being tapped with electrical tape ( $\geq 2$  revolutions).

17) Tap the Vehicle Tracking and Recovery System Brown wire to the vehicle Sky Blue ACC wire. See steps 12-16 for wire tap installation instructions.






- 18) Attach Harness
  - a) Install cable ties around Vehcile Tracking and Recovery System harness and the BCM harness.



b) Secure harness with cable tie with 560mm service loop from GPS Tracking Connector

# **A** CAUTION

- When stacking multiple ground eyelets, **DO NOT** stack the stems of the eyelet
- When stacking multiple ground eyelets, leave a 30° spacing between the stems of the eyelet



- 19) Re-attach the BCM
  - a) Re-Install (3) phillips screws.







20) Connect the harness to the control module

AC	ACCESSORY CHECK:					
	Connect all harness connections (without re-assembly)					
	Connect the battery negative terminal					
	Check all Critical Installation Steps.					
	Verify all wiring is secure and not exposed.					
	Trim all excess cable ties flush.					
	Verify the Control Module Diagnostic L.E.D.'s are blinking Green					
	Verify proper Diagnostic L.E.D. blinking pattern (without engine start)					
	Turn ignition switch to "OFF: position, the Green L.E.D. will blink bright once every three seconds					
	Turn ignition switch to "ON" position for ten seconds, the Green L.E.D. will continue to blink bright once every three seconds					
	Turn ignition switch to "OFF"position, the Green L.E.D. will be dim and blink once every three seconds					
	Secure mirror hanger to rear view mirror					
	Disconnect the negative battery terminal					
INS	STALLATION PROCEDURE:					
	ig.21  21) Mount Module.  a) Clean installation surface with ≥90% alcohol/water solution.  b) Peel tape liner from foam pad on Module					
	c) Adhere module to top of glove box d) Secure harness to glove box with foam tape 120mm from connector					

RE-INSTALLATION OF REMOVED PARTS:			
Re-install all removed vehicle parts. Refer to the vehicle service manual for more details.			
▲ CAUTION			
Use caution when re-installing interior components to avoid damage, scratches, or breaking of mounting clips. Refer to the vehicle service manual for more information.			
FINAL INSPECTION:			
Verify re-installed trim parts for proper flush fit (no gap, no waviness, etc.).			
Verify all clips are fully engaged and locked.			
Verify re-installed trim parts are free from cracks, scratches or stress marks.			
Verify vehicle headliner, seat, steering wheel, center console, floor carpets, etc. are not soiled.			
Verify interior and exterior is not damaged.			
Connect the battery negative terminal and tighten the nut to appropriate torque.			
Turn ignition switch to "ON" and confirm proper operation of Vehicle Systems  If equipped, verify all window and sunroof one touch operation and perform the reset procedure if necessary. Refer to the vehicle service manual for more details.  Confirm proper audio function (AM, FM, SAT, CD and AUX).			
Re-program radio presets and other vehicle settings to the recorded settings.			
Start engine and verify that there are no new Diagnostic Trouble Codes. Turn ignition switch to "OFF".			
Place the Owner Manual, Quick Reference Guide, and/or other Manual in the glove box.
