PRE-INSTALLATION WARNINGS, CAUTIONS, CRITICAL STEPS, and NOTES:


- Dealer Installation Recommended. Instructions may refer to Service Manual.
- This Part is to be installed at a surface temperature of 65-100°F.



CAUTION

- Install the body side molding when the ambient temperature is above 60°F (15°C).
- Do not wash or expose the vehicle to a wet environment for 24 hours after installing the rear bumper protector.
- Please use proper pressure to wet the tape on the body side molding to the door (15lbs)

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:



NOTE: FRONT OR REAR PARTS CAN BE USED ON EITHER LEFT OR RIGHT SIDE


- a) Clean middle section of door panels thoroughly with soap and water to remove any dirt or debris and allow to dry. (Fig. 1)
 - Using a clean lint free cloth and alcohol, clean the area of the panels where parts will be installed. (Fig.1)
 - c) Allow time to dry thoroughly.




CAUTION

Failure to clean the mounting surface properly may cause the adhesive tape to have poor adhesion to the vehicle.


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS - Body Side Moldings



- a) At rear edge of front door measure up 221mm from bottom lower door edge, mark with a piece of tape. (Fig. 2)
 - b)
 From rear edge of front door measure 990mm forward and 214mm from bottom lower door edge, mark with a piece of tape. (Fig. 2)




3) Mark a line 4mm from the rear edge of the front door. (Fig. 3)




4) Remove end "C" tape liner and peel back both liners at each end 50mm-60mm using tape tabs. (Fig. 4)


Note: Round end of trim is located at the front of door.





- 5) a) Position molding to rear of door at 4mm line, leave a 1mm gap between bottom edge of molding and top of tape pieces, check alignment and tack down. (Fig. 5)
 - b) Pull remainder of liners off both ends while holding part into position and tack down. (Fig. 5)
- 6) Repeat process for opposite side of vehicle.

7) Rear Panel Drivers Side

- a) At front edge of rear panel locate piece of tape, check alignment with previously installed front door molding. (Fig. 6)
- b) At front edge of rear panel measure back 1180mm and 230mm up from lower sill radius mark and locate piece of tape. (Fig. 6)
- c) Mark a line 4mm from front edge of rear panel. (Fig. 7)
- 8) Remove end "C" tape liner and peel back both liners at each end 50mm-60mm, using tape tabs. (Fig. 8)

Note: Round end of trim is located at the rear of the panel or door.

- a) Position back edge of molding to front of passengers rear door and drivers rear panel and butted to 4mm line, leave a 1mm gap between bottom edge of molding and top of tape pieces, check alignment and tack down. (Fig.9)
 - Pull remainder of liners off both ends while holding part in position and tack down. If necessary, raise centre slightly to avoid sagging. (Fig. 9)
- Once attached, apply pressure of 15lbs with roller or hand to ensure proper tape wet out of both front and rear moldings.

11) Rear Door Passenger Side

- a) At front edge of rear door locate piece of tape, check alignment with previously installed front door tape. (Fig. 6)
- b) At front edge of rear door measure back 1180mm and 224mm up from lower door edge, mark and locate piece of tape. (Fig. 6)
- c) Mark a line 4mm from front edge of rear door.(Fig. 7)
- 12) Repeat steps 8-10 for passenger side.
