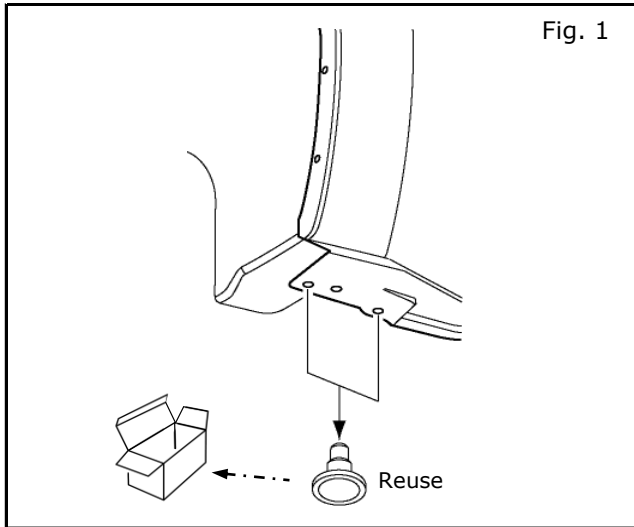
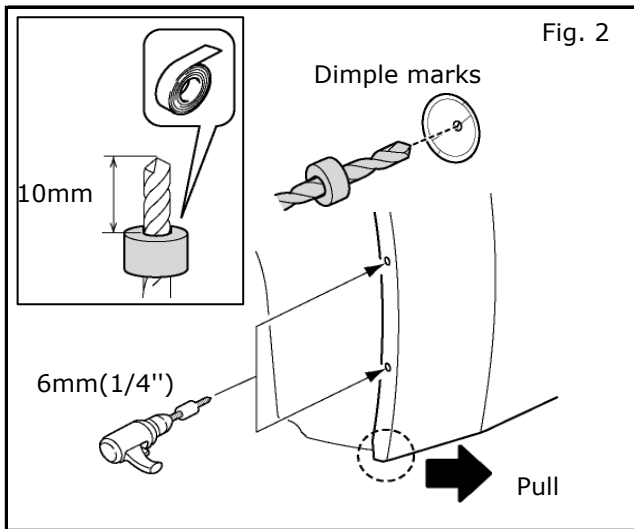


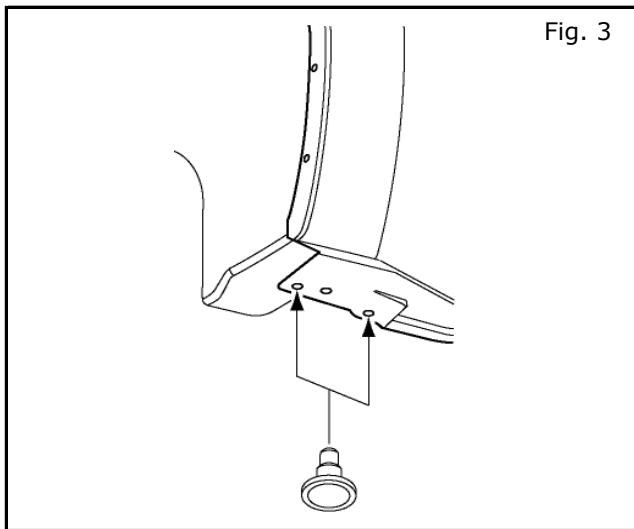
INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:



- 1) Remove clips from rear bumper and keep to reuse.

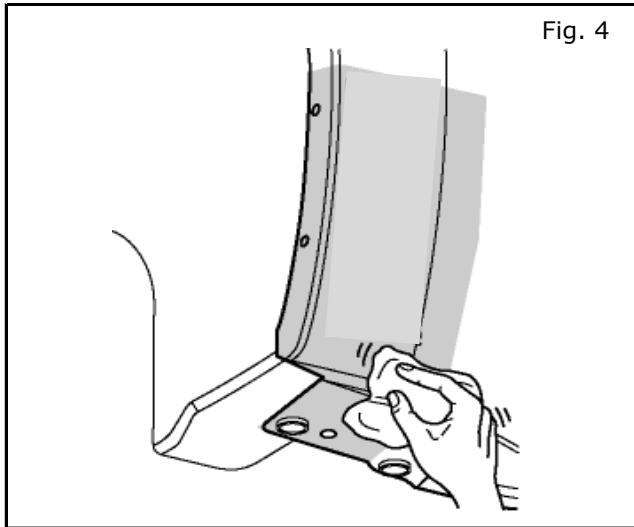


- 2) Pull out on bottom corner of rear bumper, and drill 6mm(1/4") holes at dimple locations.

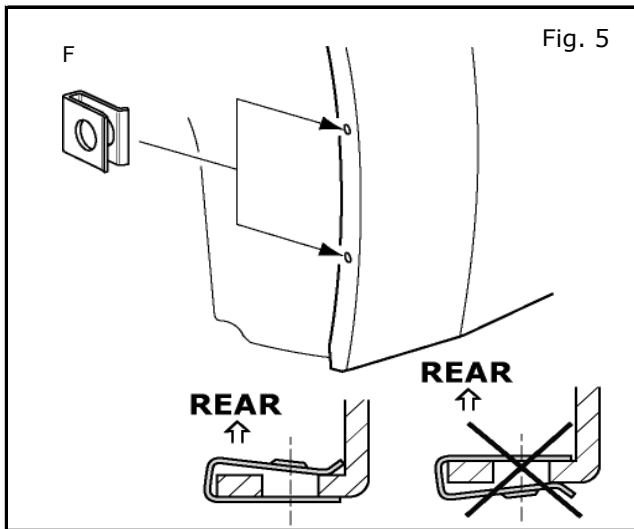


- 3) Reinstall clips.

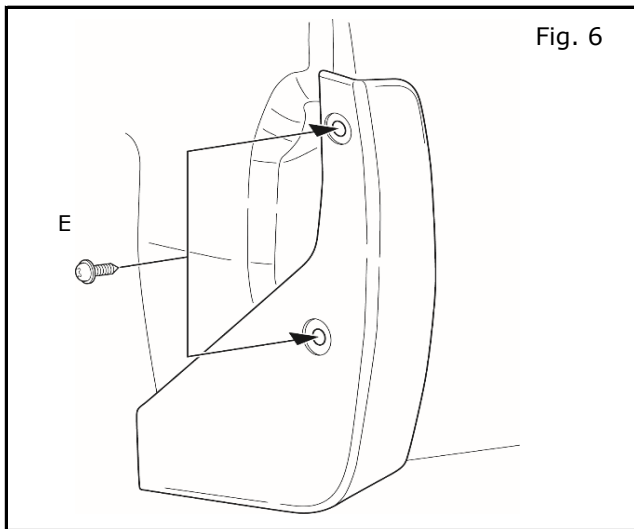
INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:



- 4) Clean installation surface (shaded area) with mild soap/water mixture.
- 5) Using a clean, lint free cloth, wipe tape area with 90% or greater alcohol.

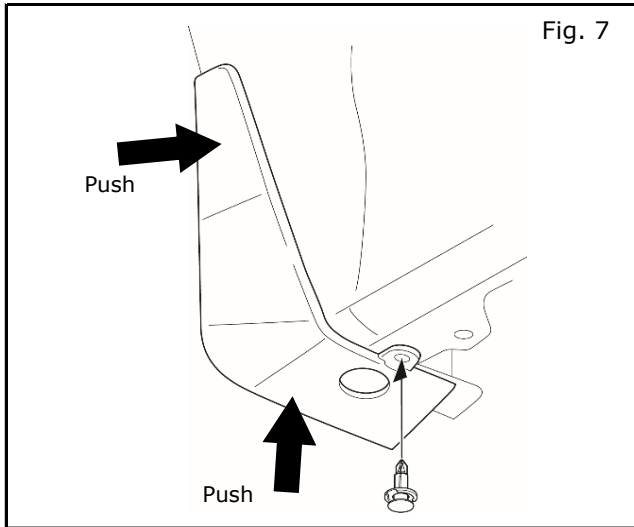


- 6) Install spring nuts(F).

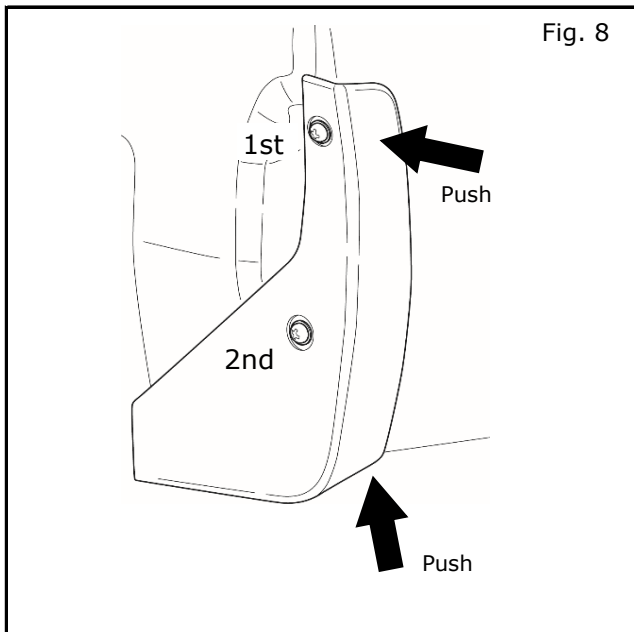


- 7) Align rear splash guard to vehicle and loosely install phillips screws(E).

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:



- 8) Push splash guard upward/inward and install clip(G).



- 9) Push splash guard upward/inward, and tighten phillips screw(E) in sequence shown.

NOTE:

Do not over tighten screws. Reference tightening torque 3.8~4.4 N-m (33.6~38.9 lb-in).

ACCESSORY CHECK:

- ☐ Check all torque values.
- ☐ Clean rear bumper near installation areas of vehicle.

FINAL INSPECTION:

- ☐ Verify exterior is not damaged.
