



#### 7. INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:










- Place the bolt through the hole in the jack nut 4. installation tool. Thread the jack nut on the bolt up to the tool. See Figure 4
- Push the jack nut into the **driver side** hole 5. where the plastic trim clip was located and, applying constant pressure to keep the nut against the sheet metal, turn the bolt with the wrench to collapse the nut. Once the nut is collapsed and secure from spinning unscrew the bolt.
- Reinstall the rear trim sill and push one of the 6. plastic trim clips in the passenger side hole to secure it. If both of the trim clips were damaged during removal, use an appropriate replacement. Reinstall the weatherseal and load floor.
- 7. Place a cover sheet or rag over the trim to protect it and slide the organizer into the rear well.

Once down in the well, remove the trim 8. protection, pull the organizer rearward and align the knob stud with the trim and jack nut hole. Thread the knob into the jack nut until the rear wall of the organizer just touches the plastic rear sill.

Reinstall the parcel shelf (if applicable).



- Maximum load of 150lbs (68Kg)
- 9. Store the charge kit in the small bin. See Figure 6
